 - 1) the location of the human being as the central value and concern.
 - 2) the affirmation of the equality of all human beings.
 - 3) the recognition of personal and cultural diversity; affirming the characteristics proper to each people and condemning all discrimination including that based on racial, ethnic or cultural differences.
 - 4) an emphasis on the development of knowledge beyond that accepted as conventional wisdom or that imposed as absolute truth.
 - 5) the affirmation of the freedom of ideas and beliefs; and
 - 6) the rejection of all forms of violence not only physical but also economic, racial, religious, moral and psychological.
- iv) to promote social voluntarism, solidarity, reciprocity and continuity in the development of these objectives.
- v) to promote the idea of development (individual, social, economic etc), by all and for all, with an awareness of the importance of ecology and the environment as elements essential for human life.
